There are few viticulture or growing areas in the United States that are suited so specifically for a certain grape varietal. It is this uniqueness of soil, geography and climate that makes this special region so intriguing for winemakers, growers and consumers alike. Pinot Noir has made it's home in this area characterized as a temperate rainforest while also being an emerging home to crisp white varietals like Pinot Gris and Gewurztraminer. Variance from vintage to vintage is much more common here than other West Coast growing regions that are offered much more consistency.

While the soil and topography may be unique, it is the community of growers seeking common goals together that truly makes this a region of growing respect and intrigue alike.

OUR WINES

Annually, we focus our resources on our Flagship Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. As we explore each vintage with our growing partners, we encounter lots from some of the most prestigious vineyards in Oregon and carefully select a few rows of grapes for our Reserve program. As a boutique producer, we limit these offerings to anywhere between 4 and 10 barrels for our AVA specific Reserve and Single Vineyards series.

We have our eyes on some white varietals in the 2022 harvest and look forward to sharing some of our favorite expressions from the soils and climates of this diverse valley.
